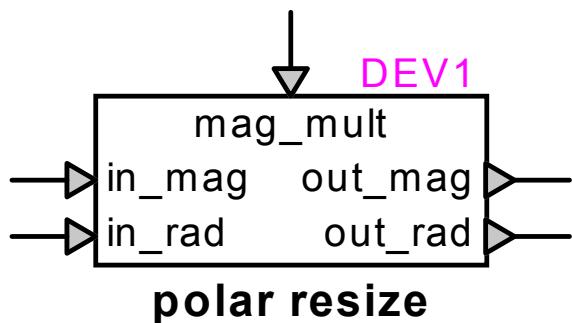


Phasor operation : polar resize



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1 Description

This device modifies the magnitude of a vector or phasor represented by its polar coordinates.

1.1 Pins

This device has five pins:

| <i>pin</i> | <i>type</i> | <i>description</i> | <i>units</i> |
|------------|-------------|----------------------|-------------------------------|
| in_mag | input pin | input magnitude | any |
| in_rad | input pin | input angle | rad |
| mag_mult | input pin | magnitude multiplier | any |
| out_mag | output pin | output magnitude | units(in_mag)*units(mag_mult) |
| out_rad | output pin | output angle | rad |

1.2 Parameters

No parameters are required for this device.

1.3 Input

The input pins may be connected to any control signals.

1.4 Output

The outputs are the polar coordinates of the input vector resized by a variable multiplier.

The operation is immediate, and is calculated as follows:

```
out_mag = in_mag * multiplier  
out_rad = in_rad
```
